### **Edward Victor Gant Scholarship (UCONN)**

- ⇒ \$1,500 scholarships.
- ⇒ Scholarship awarded to an undergraduate student who will be enrolled at UConn in the Fall.
- ⇒ Priority consideration will be given to those undergraduate students who have more than four semesters of enrollment at UConn. The scholarships are open to students from all schools and colleges.
- ⇒ Faculty and staff may nominate students by writing letters of support. The letters must address all four of the areas noted above. The student's name and PeopleSoft Id must also appear on all supporting documentation.
- ⇒ Nominations & letters of support from faculty members who have interacted with the students are especially helpful.
- ⇒ Students may not apply directly.

### **Frontiers in Undergraduate Research (UCONN)**

- ⇒ Is the annual poster exhibition of student research, scholarship, and creative projects.
- ⇒ Frontiers will be held on Friday, April 11, 2008, and Saturday, April 12, 2008.
- ⇒ Any undergraduate student may apply to showcase his or her work. ### **Mitchell Scholarship (UCONN)**

- ⇒ Awarded to students with the potential to become national leaders. Students must have unusual depth in their academic interests and exceptional records of focused contributions to society. Mitchell Scholars may study at any institution in Ireland or Northern Ireland.
- ⇒ The typical pre-applicant is a junior. Those selected as UConn nominees will be mentored as they write their applications for the national competition in the Fall

### **NATA Entry Level Scholarship**

- ⇒ Applicant must have a cumulative overall GPA of at least 3.2 (based on a 4.0 maximum) for **ALL** undergraduate courses and **ALL** graduate courses (if applicable) to date (minimum of 5 semesters or 7 quarters)
- ⇒ Applicant must be enrolled in a CAATA accredited undergraduate program requiring four years for a baccalaureate degree, and may apply during his/her junior year, or immediately prior to his/her final undergraduate academic year (provided that the submission/postmark date requirement is met)
- ⇒ Applicant must be enrolled in a CAATE accredited entry level masters program.
- ⇒ Applicant must have performed with distinction as a participant in his/her athletic training program, academic major, institution and intercollegiate athletics.
- ⇒ Applicant must confirm his/her intent to pursue the athletic training profession as his/her primary means of livelihood.

### **SURF (Summer Undergraduate Research Fund)**

- ⇒ Provides up to \$3500 in funding for students to participate in research, scholarship, or creative projects over the summer.
- ⇒ \$3000 is a stipend for the student based on 10 weeks of work; the remaining \$500 can be applied toward equipment expenses incurred by the student or the faculty member during the pursuit of research.
- ⇒ Undergraduate students who will continue to be full-time students through Spring semester 2009 are encouraged to apply.
