

Athletic Training Student Guidelines:

1. The student athletic trainer will report promptly when scheduled. This includes treatments, practices, games, meetings, in service, and other activities deemed essential by the administrative athletic training staff.
2. The student athletic trainer will dress in the appropriate attire when representing the athletic training program. The student will wear the uniform of the day or dress appropriately for the event they will be working. Professional appearance is expected at all times.

Appropriate Attire:

Collar shirt
UConn Athletic Training T-shirt
Slacks
Shorts -mid-thigh length
Wind pants
Khaki's

Inappropriate Attire:

T-shirt w/ unprofessional message
Torn Clothing
Sweat Pants
Sweat Shirts (non UCONN)
Caps or Hats (indoors)
Spandex
Blue Jeans
Body piercing (exception female ears only)

GAME COVERAGE- OUTDOORS

Appropriate Attire:

Collar shirt (prefer one with UConn logo)
Navy, Royal blue, Khaki or Black Dress Pants (no jeans)
Rain Suit or UConn Athletic Training Jackets as dictated by the weather

NOTE: When more than one Athletic Trainer is assigned to the sports, attire is to be coordinated.

GAME COVERAGE -INDOORS

Students are expected to wear dress clothes at indoor events. Exceptions to this rule are Volleyball Tournaments and Swimming Events. Athletic Training polo shirts and slacks are acceptable for Volleyball Tournaments, Athletic Training shirt and blue shorts for Swimming events.
