*RECIPIENTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA

- Be a full-time entering graduate student pursuing a teaching certification in mathematics or a science discipline.
- Commit to teach in a high-needs school for a minimum of two years.
- Have an outstanding academic record- minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Be either a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
