Storrs, Conn. - Neag School of Education Assistant Professor Courtney Bell is one of two young researchers selected from candidates throughout the country for a prestigious “Fellowship in Measurement” sponsored by the American Educational Research Association and the Education Testing Service.



Beginning in May, Dr. Bell will spend one year training and conducting research at the Educational Testing Service facility in New Jersey, where she will focus on developing reliable methods for measuring teacher learning.

Dr. Bell holds a joint appointment in the Neag School of Education’s departments of Educational Leadership and Curriculum and Instruction. During the past two years, she has been the recipient two other honors for her scholarly work -- the Spencer Dissertation Fellowship and the AERA-Division L Dissertation Award.
