1. Fill out an application online for an Initial License:

2. You must download and complete the verification of out-of-state program form: <http://www.doe.mass.edu/edprep/nasdtec.html> and mail to Dr. Yuhang Rong, Assistant Dean, Neag School of Education, University of Connecticut, 249 Glenbrook Road, Unit 2064, Storrs, CT 06269-2064.
3. Copy of Connecticut license (front and back)
4. Official transcripts from the University.
5. Tests

 - Subject area test(s) - www.doe.mass.edu/mtel/testrequire.html/
 - Elementary Education candidates may be able to waive the MTEL Foundations of Reading Test with their Connecticut Foundations of Reading Test score; see “obtaining your test results” at the website below
